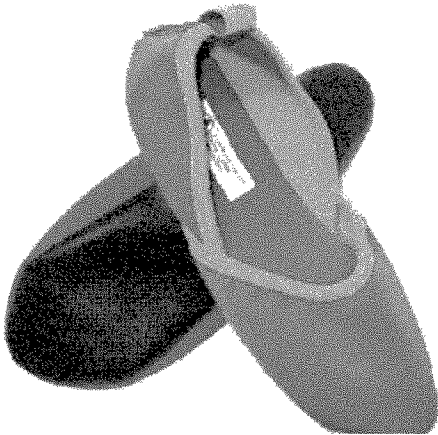


Don't vacation without these travel products

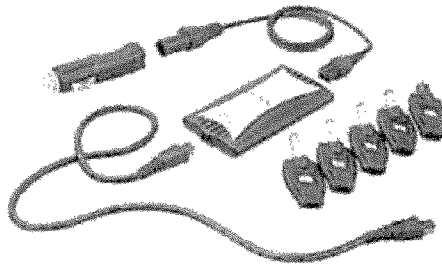


Athlete's foot barriers

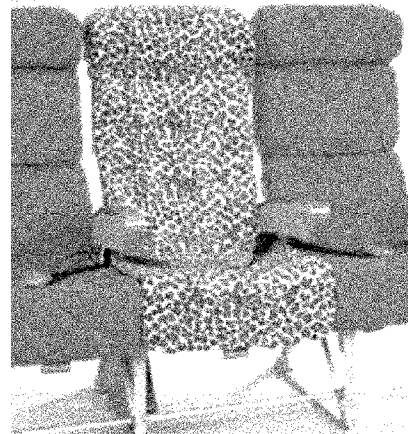
Satisfy your power hunger
